## Prof. dr Mehmedin Tahirović

**Mehmedin (Mumin) Tahirović** was born on September 20, 1959, in Biševo, Rožaje Municipality, Montenegro. He completed his primary education in 1973 and then graduated from **high school gymnasium**, with a focus on social and linguistic studies in 1977. In 1981, he graduated from the **Military Academy land forces of the Army** in Belgrade. In mid-October 2005, he earned a **Master of Laws degree at the Faculty of Law** in Podgorica, Department of Political Science, with a thesis titled "*Civil Control of Security Forces in the States Formed After the Dissolution of the Former SFRY, with a Special Focus on Montenegro.*"

In July 2011, he defended his **doctoral dissertation** on "*Montenegro and Euro-Atlantic Security Integrations*" at the Faculty of Philosophy at the University of Mostar, Bosnia and Herzegovina. He earned the title of Doctor of Science in the field of social sciences, political science, with a specialization in *international relations and national security*. This qualification was officially recognized by the Ministry of Education and Sports of Montenegro on September 6, 2011.

He is proficient in English and Russian.

As part of his doctoral dissertation, he developed the **project** "*Montenegro and the NATO Partnership for Peace Program*" as a fellow of the American-German Marshall Center for Security Studies in Garmisch-Partenkirchen, Germany, earning the title of "Marshall Center Scholarship."

On March 14, 2012, the Senate of the University of Donja Gorica approved the decision of the Teaching and Scientific Council to recognize Dr. Mehmedin Tahirović as an **Docent Dr.** in the scientific field of *Regional Security and Crisis Management* at the Faculty of Humanistic studies.

Based on the approval of the Senate of the University of Travnik, Bosnia and Herzegovina, on November 24, 2022, the Faculty of Law in Kiseljak of the University of Travnik appointed Docent Dr. Mehmedin Tahirović as an *Associate Professor in the narrower scientific field of International Law*.

From 2012 to 2017, he was engaged as an **Associate Professor at the University of Donja Gorica** in Podgorica, Faculty of Humanities, teaching subjects at the basic studies in *Crisis Management*, Defense Policies, and *Regional Security* at the postgraduate level.

From September 2021 for the academic year 2021/2022, he was re-engaged as an Associate Professor at the Faculty of Humanities at the University of Donja Gorica, teaching subjects in *Crisis Management, Defense Policies, Security Strategies*, and *Global Security* at the undergraduate level. For the academic year 2022/2023/2024, he was again engaged in teaching *Defense Policies*, *Security Strategies* and *Global Security*.

From 2014 to 2017, he was also a **lecturer at the Police Academy** in Danilovgrad, teaching the subject "*National Security and EU Security*."

Throughout his thirty-eight-year career in the security sector, he held various positions in the military structures of the Yugoslav People Army (JNA) and and the Army of Yugoslavia (VJ) from 1981 to 1996, particularly as a *commander and lecturer at the Military Academy* and a research scientist at the Institute for Strategic Research in Belgrade from 1991 to 1995, where he earned the title of an *independent research scientist*.

After leaving the Army of Yugoslavia in 1996, he continued his **work in the police structures** of the *Ministry of Internal Affairs of Montenegro and the Police Directorate of Montenegro from 1996 to 2007*. During this period, his significant involvement in the formation of the *Police Academy in Danilovgrad* and the development of a modern curriculum as an *independent inspector for unification and standardization* was particularly notable for the academy's successful functioning.

From 2002 to 2006, he was also engaged in this institution as a **Police Training Instructor**, teaching subjects such as *Communications* and *Community Policing*.

From 2007 to 2017, he worked at the **Ministry of Defense of Montenegro** in roles such as Independent Advisor for the Partnership for Peace, Head of the NATO Department, Head of the Arms Control Departmen, Head of the Department for Defense System Analysis and Development, and Chief of Public Relations and Protocol Service.

He was promoted to the rank of Colonel in the Montenegrin Army in December 2009.

From 2017 to 2019, he served as **Montenegro's first National Military Representative (NMR)** at NATO's Supreme Headquarters Allied Powers Europe (SHAPE) in Belgium.

For the majority of his career until Montenegro's independence restoration in 2006, he served as a commander and lecturer at the Military Academy in Belgrade for seven years (1984-1991), as a research scientist at the Institute for Strategic Research JNA and VJ in Belgrade (4.5 years: 1991-1995), and as an inspector and lecturer at the Police Academy in Danilovgrad (4.5 years: 2002-2006).

From June 1992 to May 1994, he was a member of the team drafting the *Military Doctrine* of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, realized by the Institute for War Skills in Belgrade.

From January 2005 to March 2006, he was engaged as an **expert in drafting** *the Law on Civil Control of the Security and Defense Sector* in the Committee for Defense and Security of the Federal Assembly of Yugoslavia.

From May 2003 to June 2005, he was part of the team for the **project "Police Education Reform in Montenegro,"** realized by the Police Academy in Danilovgrad.

From June to October 2008, he led the team drafting the Communication Strategy on Euro-Atlantic Integrations of Montenegro.

From May 2009 to July 2010, he was a **member of the team of the Montenegrin Academy of Sciences and Arts – CANU**, on the project "*Montenegro in the 21st Century – in the Era of Competitiveness*," a sub-project on "Integration into European and Euro-Atlantic Structures."

From April 2012 to the end of 2015, he participated in the realization of the **national project** "Security Aspects of Euro-Atlantic Integration of Montenegro," conducted by the University of Donja Gorica (UDG). The project leader was Professor Vlatko Cvrtilo, Zagreb, Croatia.

From 2008 to 2015, he was engaged in the governmental **Coordination Team for the Implementation of the Communication Strategy** on Euro-Atlantic Integrations of Montenegro, and from June 2015 to June 2017, he served as a member of the governmental Communication Team of the Council for NATO Membership of Montenegro.

During 2009 and 2010, he was a member of the Ministry of Defense team drafting responses to the **European Commission Questionnaire**, and during 2009 and 2012, he was part of the Ministry of Defense team drafting the *Strategic Defense Review*.

From early 2008 to 2013, he was engaged by the Human Resources Directorate of the Government of Montenegro as a lecturer for the training of state officials and civil servants in state institutions and local officials and parliamentarians in all municipalities in Montenegro on topics such as: 1. Montenegro on the Path to NATO; 2. International Security and Montenegro – UN, EU, NATO, and OSCE; and 3. National Security System of Montenegro. Additionally, during 2011 and 2012, he was engaged by the Human Resources Directorate and the Ministry of Human and Minority Rights of Montenegro as a lecturer on the topic "Gender Issues in the Security Sector."

From January 2013 to 2016, he was engaged by the Human Resources Directorate of Montenegro as a **lecturer on the topic** "*Montenegro's Integration into NATO*," educating state and local officials and representatives in local parliaments and high school teachers in all municipalities in Montenegro. He was also engaged by the Human Resources Directorate of Montenegro as a lecturer on the topic "*Security Culture in State Institutions – Security Culture in NATO and the EU*" from March 2016 to June 2017.

Since 2009, he has been the **founder and president of the Marshall Center Association in Montenegro**. From November 1, 2011, to November 1, 2012, he served as *the first chairman of the regional Marshall Center Association for Security in Southeast Europe*.

In cooperation with experts from the UK Ministry of Defence, he developed the **Crisis Communication Plan** *for the Ministry of Defence and the Army of Montenegro* in 2016.

From 2005 to 2017, he **delivered over 380 lectures on Montenegro's Euro-Atlantic integrations** *in state and local structures, organized by the Human Resources Directorate of Montenegro and various NGOs in Montenegro*. These lectures involved 28 NATO and EU member state ambassadors in Montenegro. Additionally, he conducted 40 lectures on Montenegro's Euro-Atlantic integrations organized by NGOs in Montenegro and 27 lectures abroad in English, organized by the Marshall Center, various international organizations, and embassies accredited in Montenegro.

From April 1 to May 30, 2022, he was engaged as the chief **consultant in the Ministry of Health of Montenegro** for the formation of the "*Emergency Operation Center (EOC)*" under consulting contracts No. 11-100/22-1124/1 and No. 11-100/22-1124/2.

From March 2024, engaged as an **Expert - consultant in the Ministry of Defense** on the basis of the Agreement on the work of the Minister of Defense 2696/2 dated March 1, 2024, for the following areas:

- performing consulting services for the needs of the Ministry of Defense in connection with NATO

defense planning;

- making proposals for the improvement of strategic documents in the field of defense and
- organizing lectures for young people and students about the benefits and obligations of Montenegro as well NATO members.

Since December 2024, he has been engaged as a **professor at the doctoral studies of the Faculty of Law** in Kiseljak, University of Travnik, Bosnia and Herzegovina.
